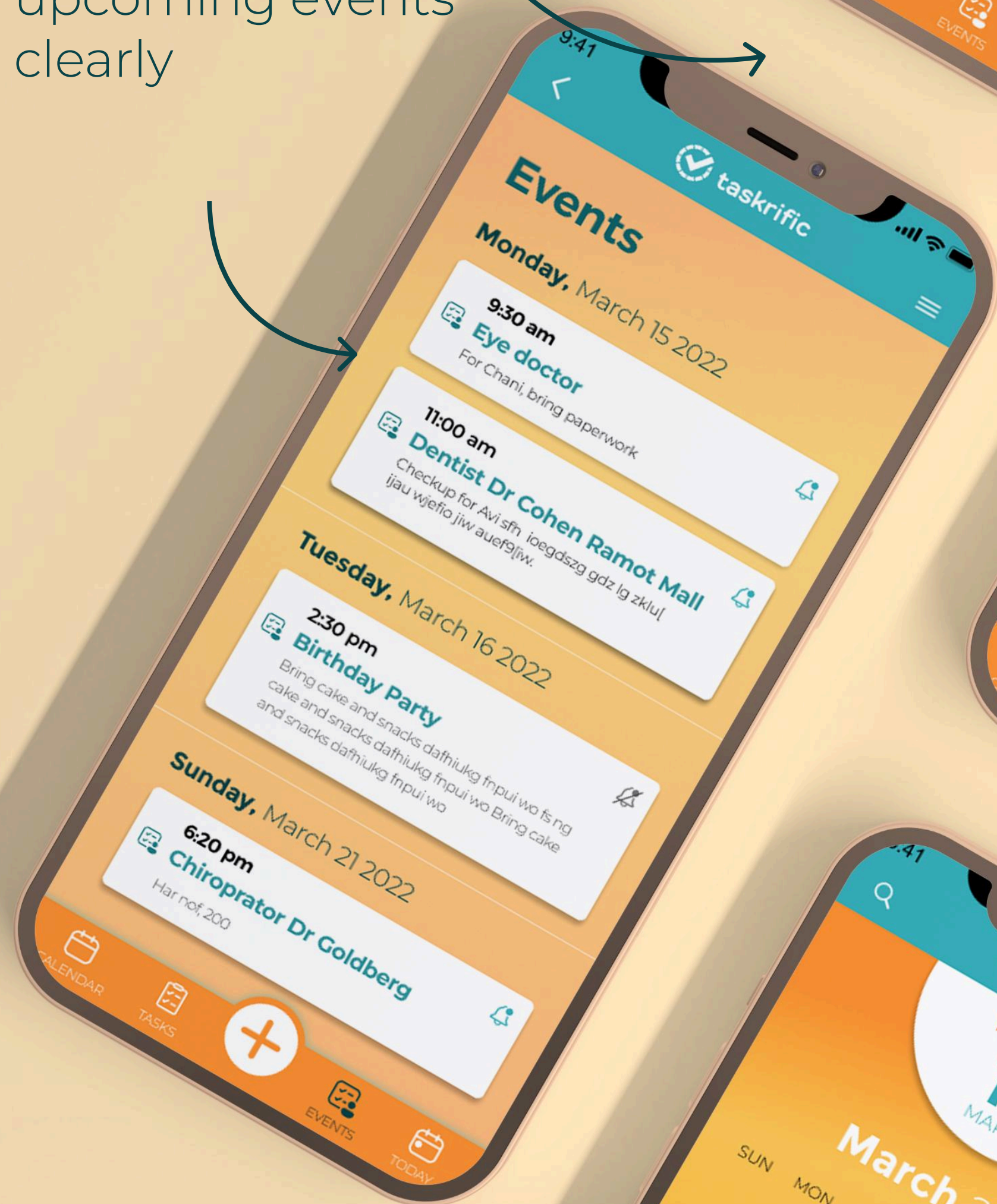


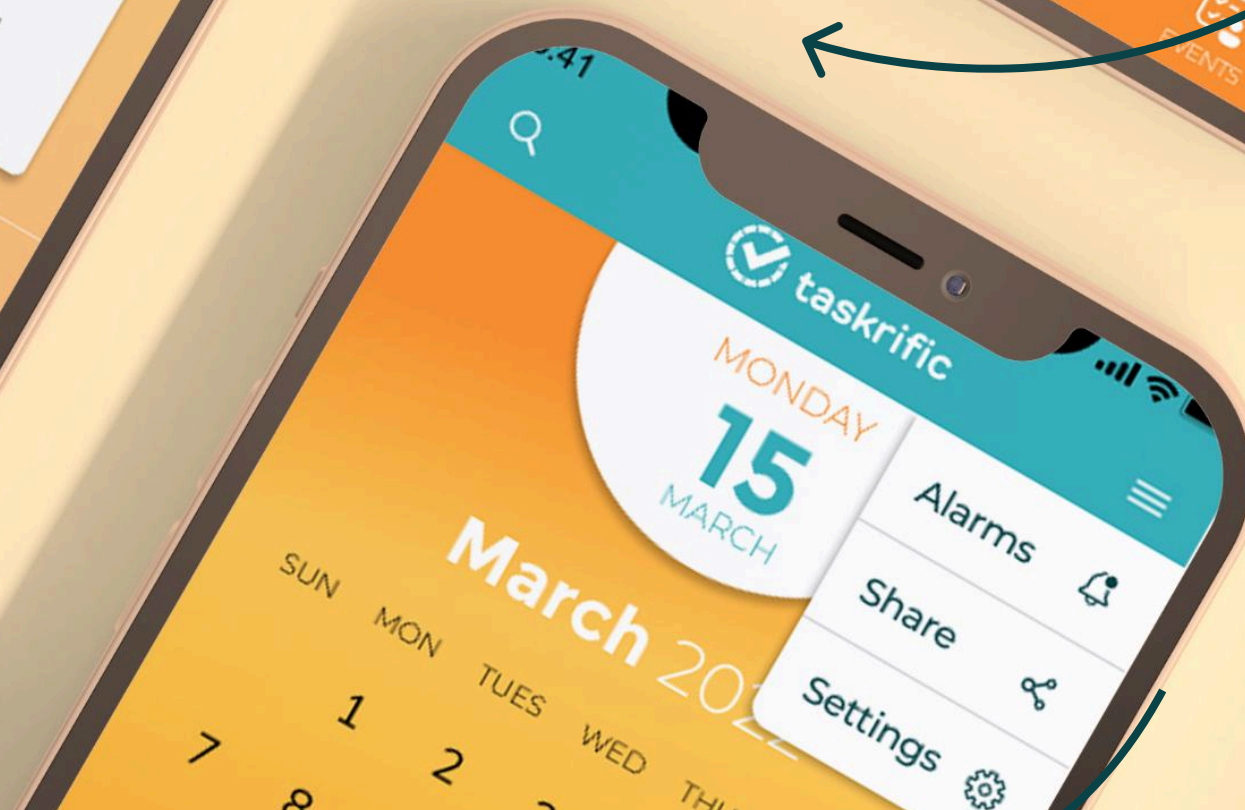

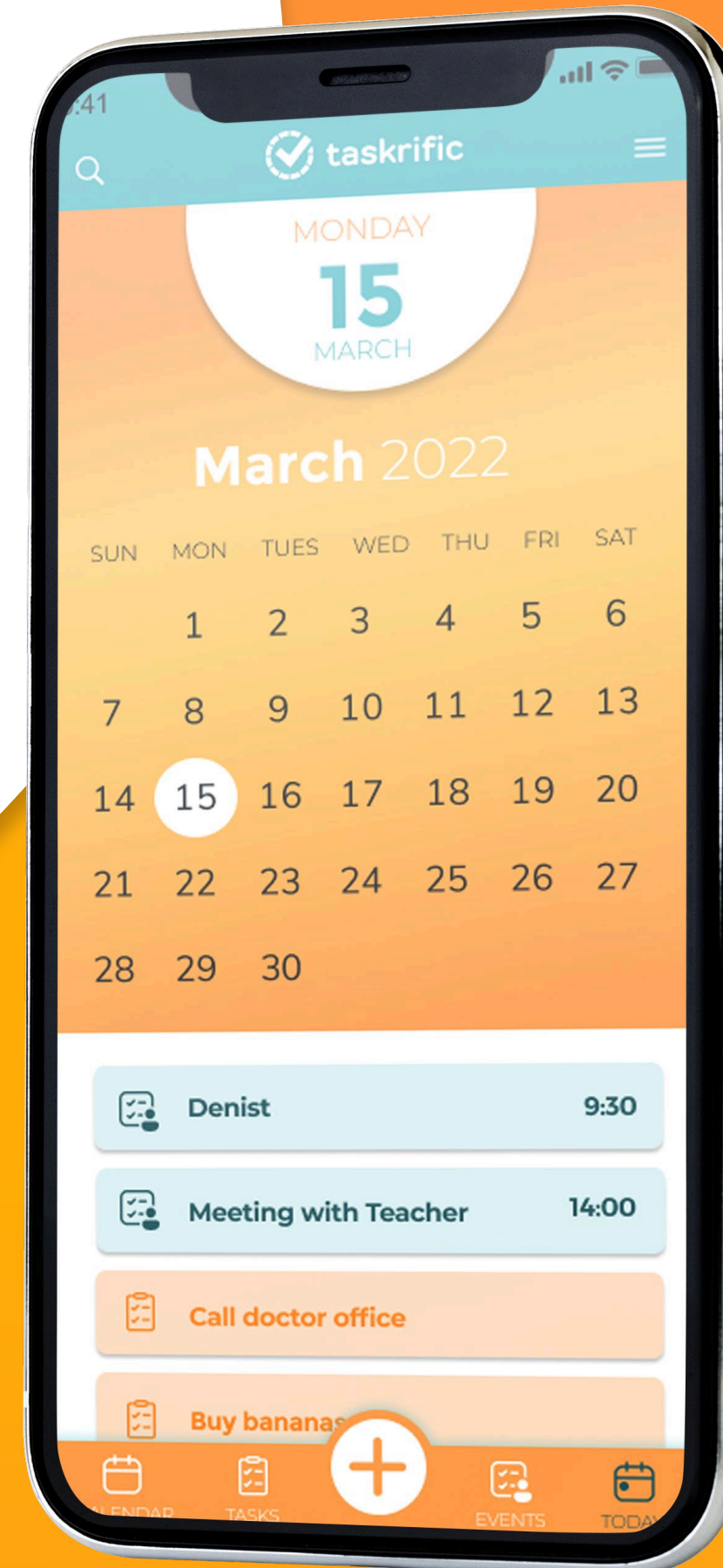

THE PROBLEM

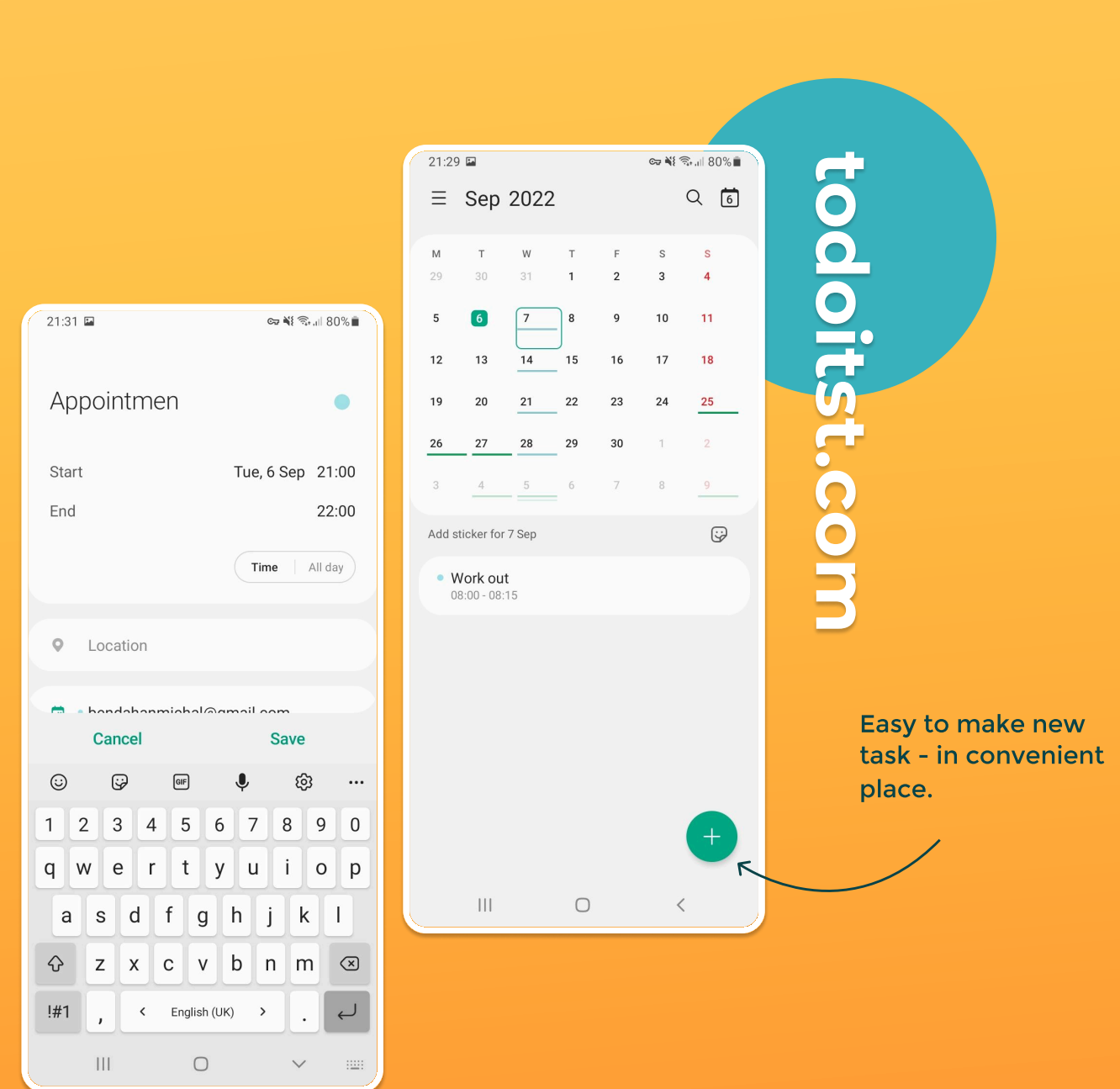
People need a place to keep track of events and tasks, so they don't forget them. Occasionally tasks also need to be shared with others.

THE SOLUTION

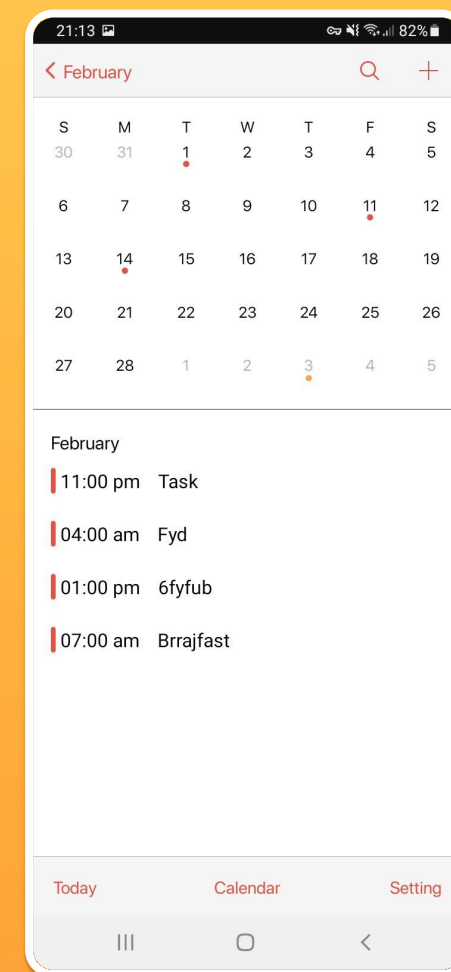
Recreate a task app that includes an alarm feature & sharing options. I will also make it easy to create new tasks.

Stage 1: Research and Empathise

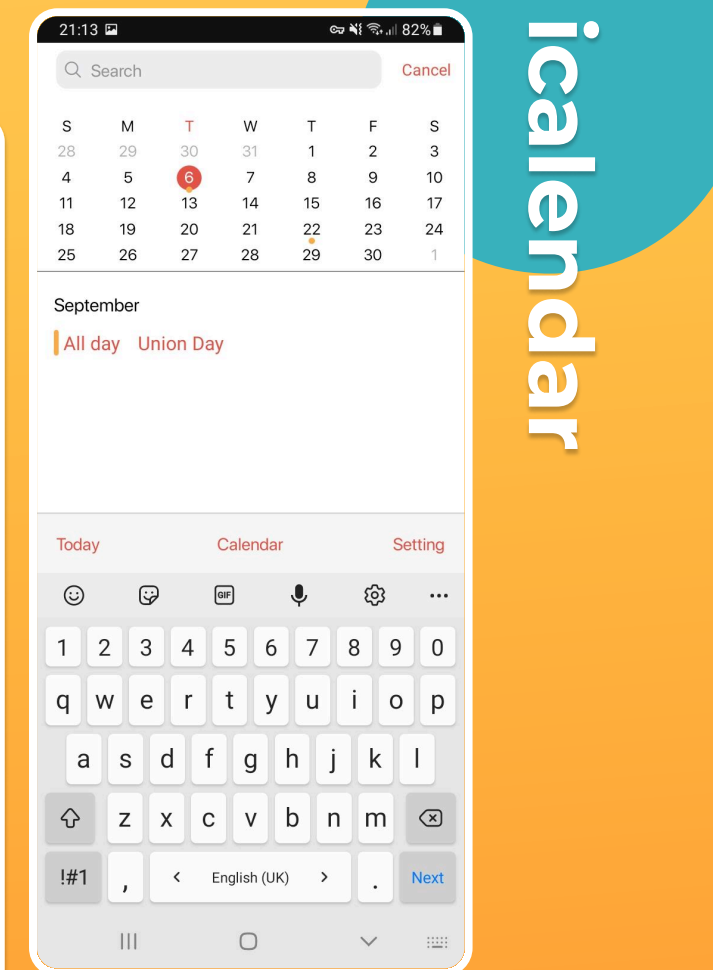
I needed to see what currently existed and how they could be improved to suit peoples needs.
Therefore, I researched other calendar/task apps to compare pros and painpoints.



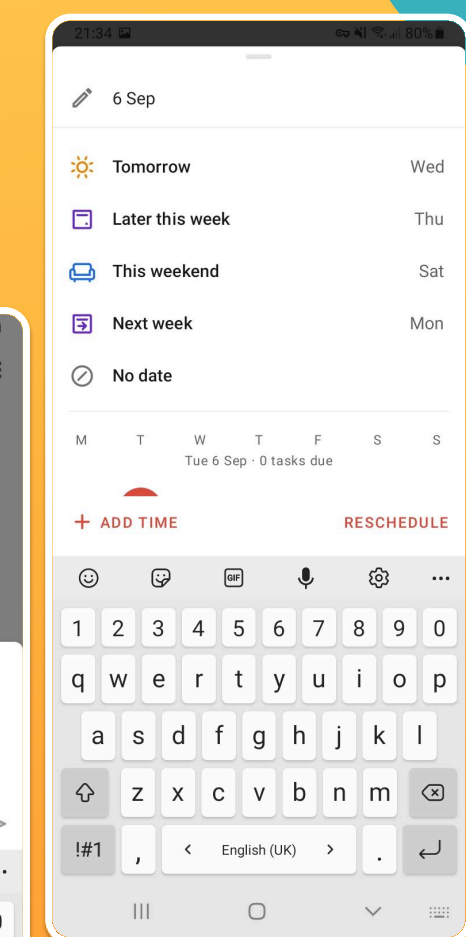
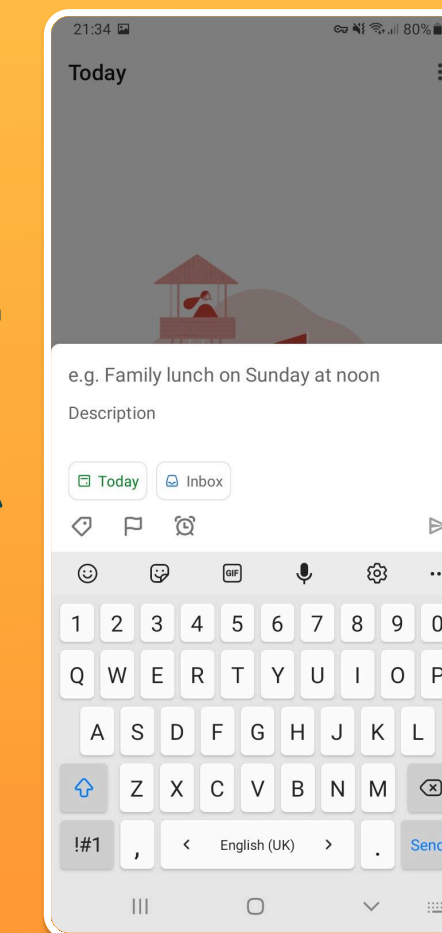
Clearly shows upcoming events

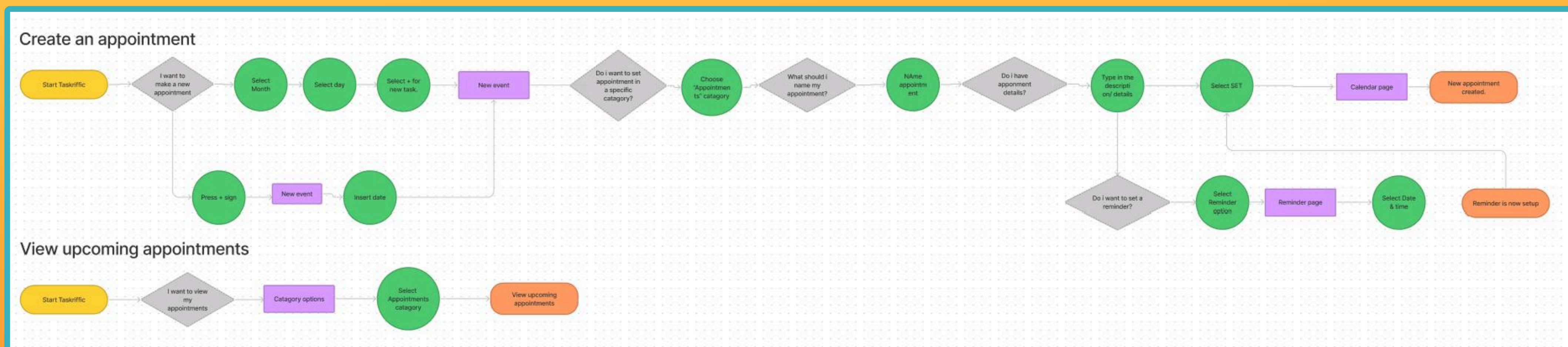
The potential users are busy adults, who need to keep track of their many tasks and appointments as well as share schedules / tasks with other people.

Stage 3: Ideating & design

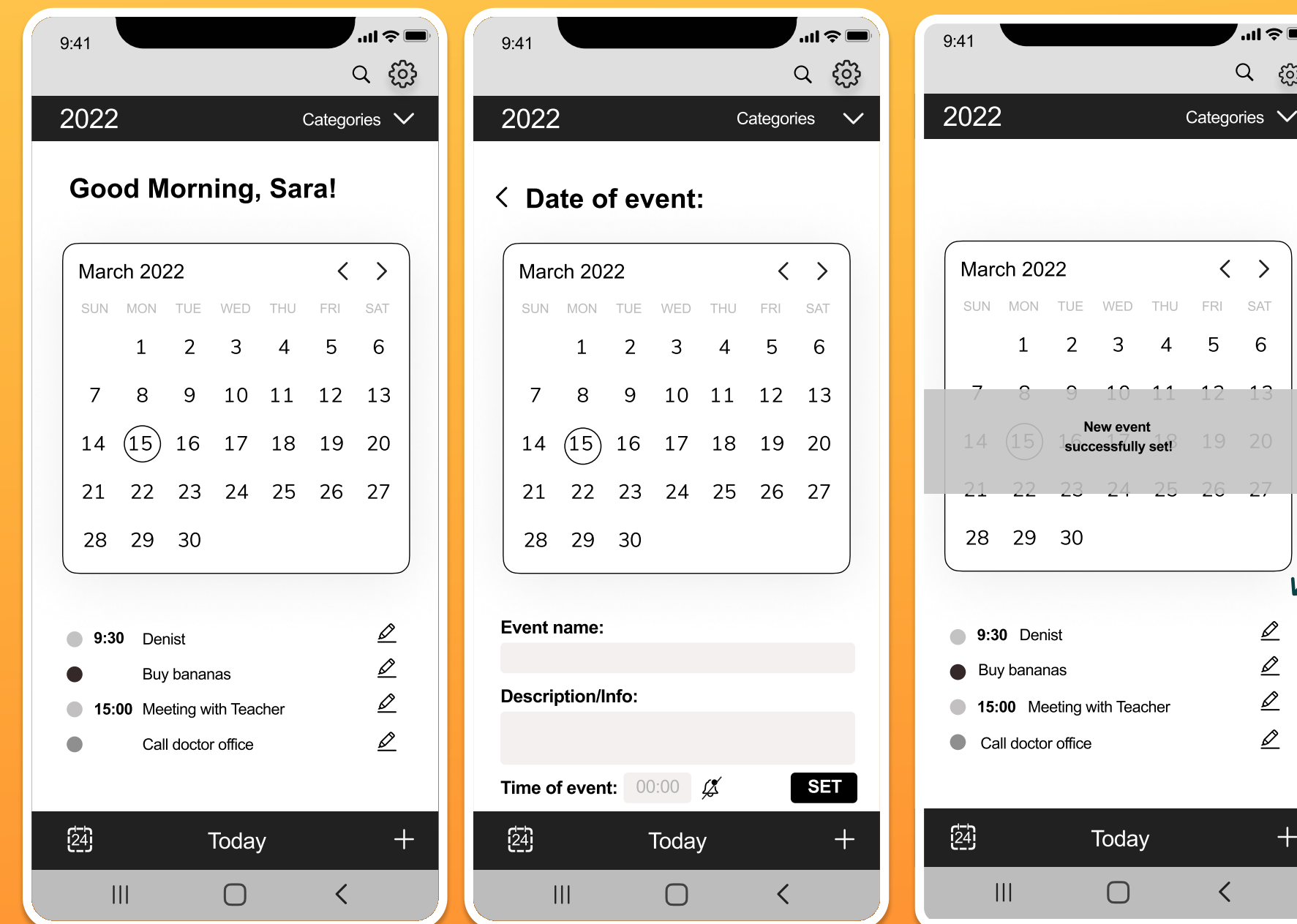
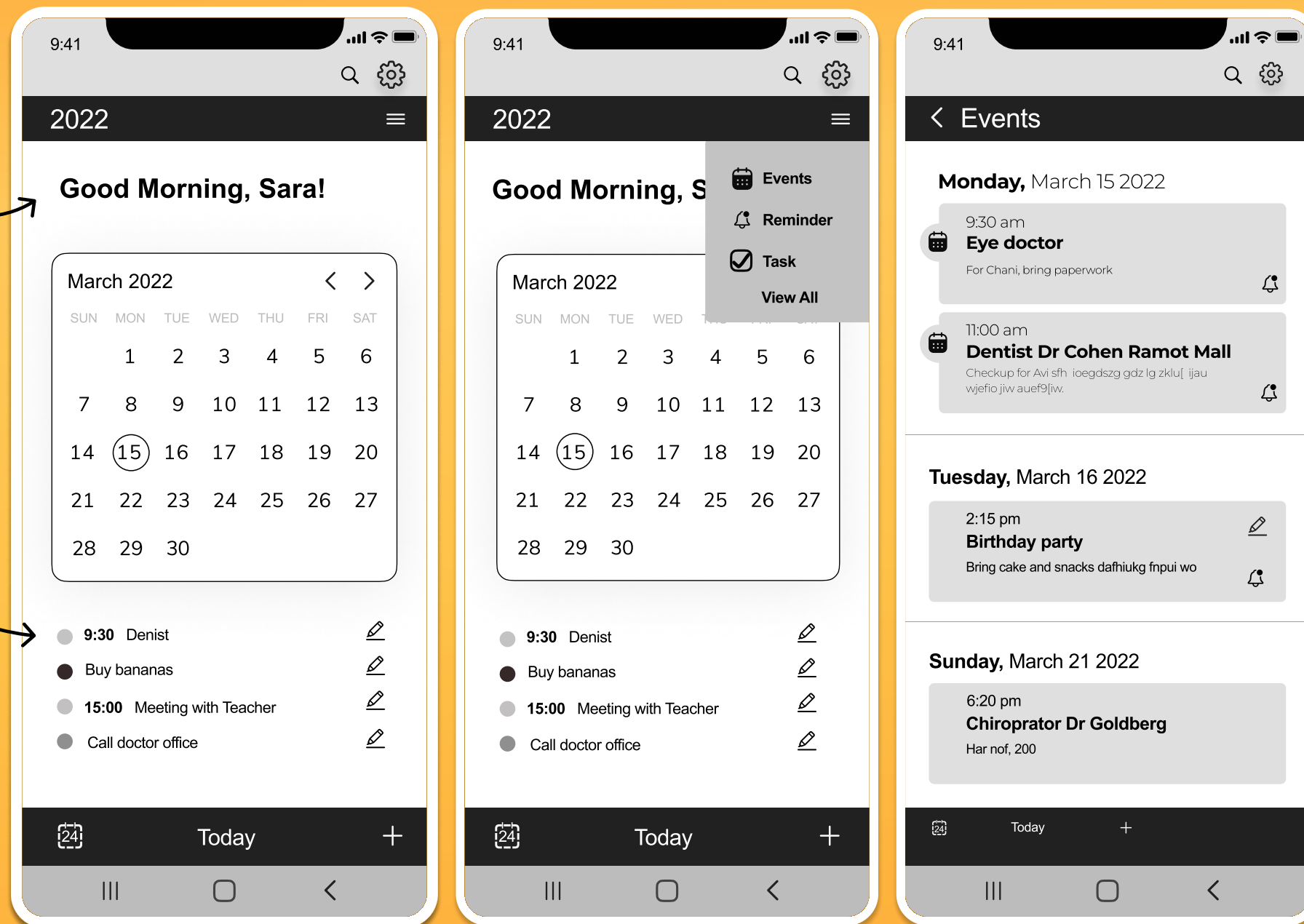
I worked on some user flows, trying to iron out any flow issues and making sure the regular steps users would take through the app were logical and intuitive.



I was then ready to work on the wireframes for the app.

I worked on Figma to figure out what elements would be placed where on the screen.

I noticed that some elements were making the screen too crowded/confusing so I removed them.



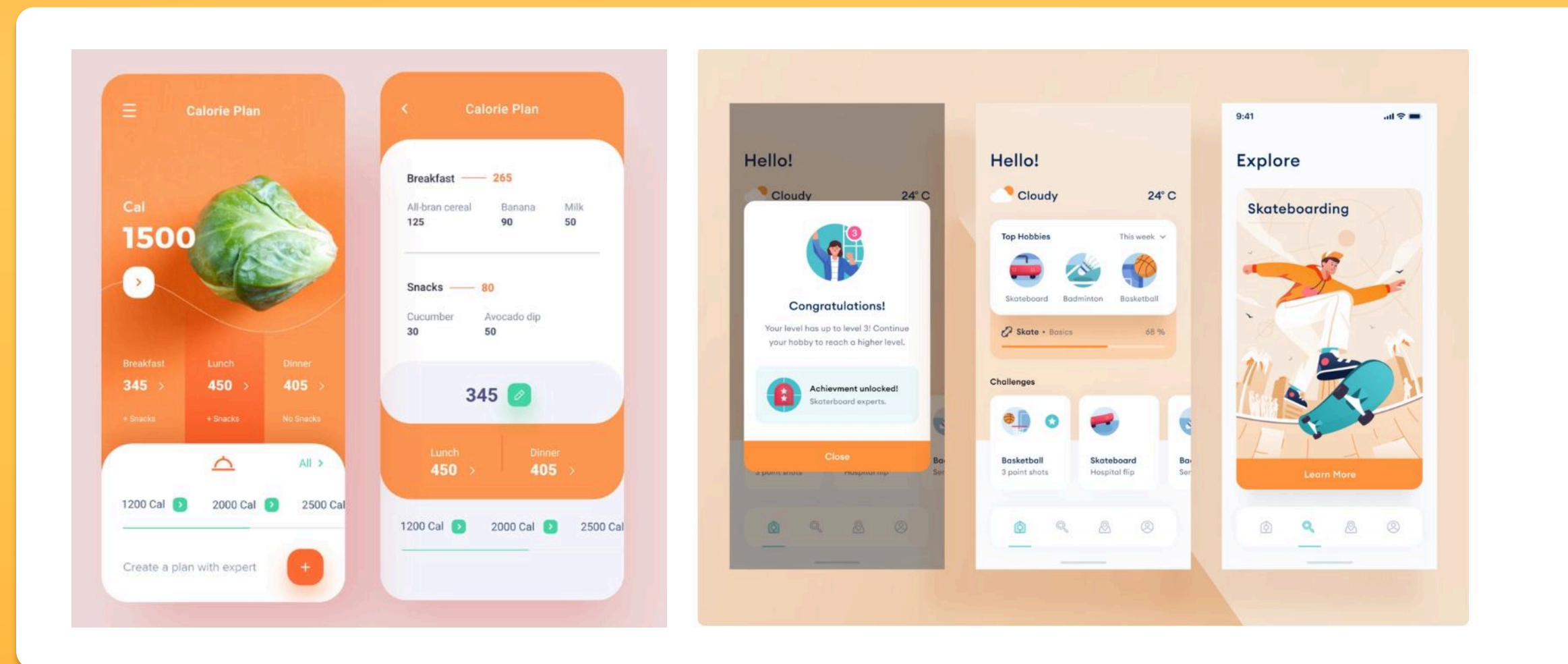
In addition, I improved the navigation, to make the app more user-friendly, with clear icons & distinct button to add new event.

Stage 4: UI Designing

Then it was time for doing the actual design. I went through a few revisions until I got the feel that was right.

I researched designs and I liked the orange base colour (left) while incorporating hints of teal (right).

I included the yellow/orange gradient to compliment the logo.

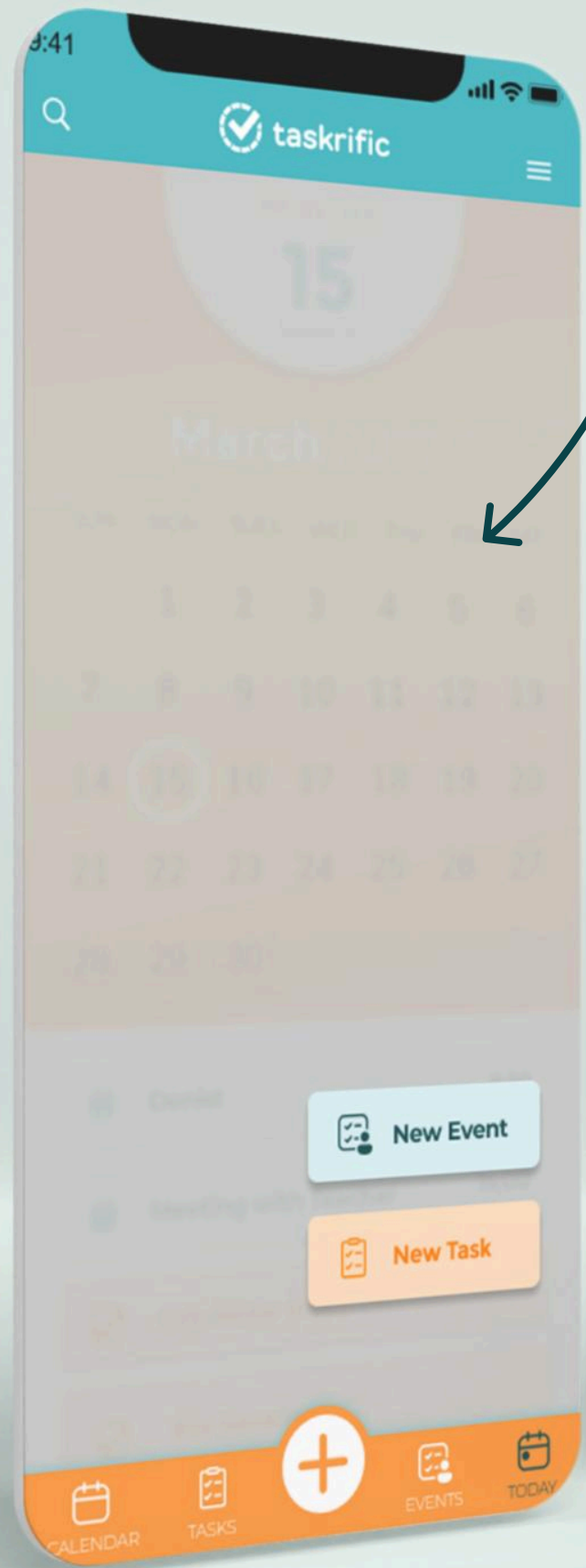
Final Design

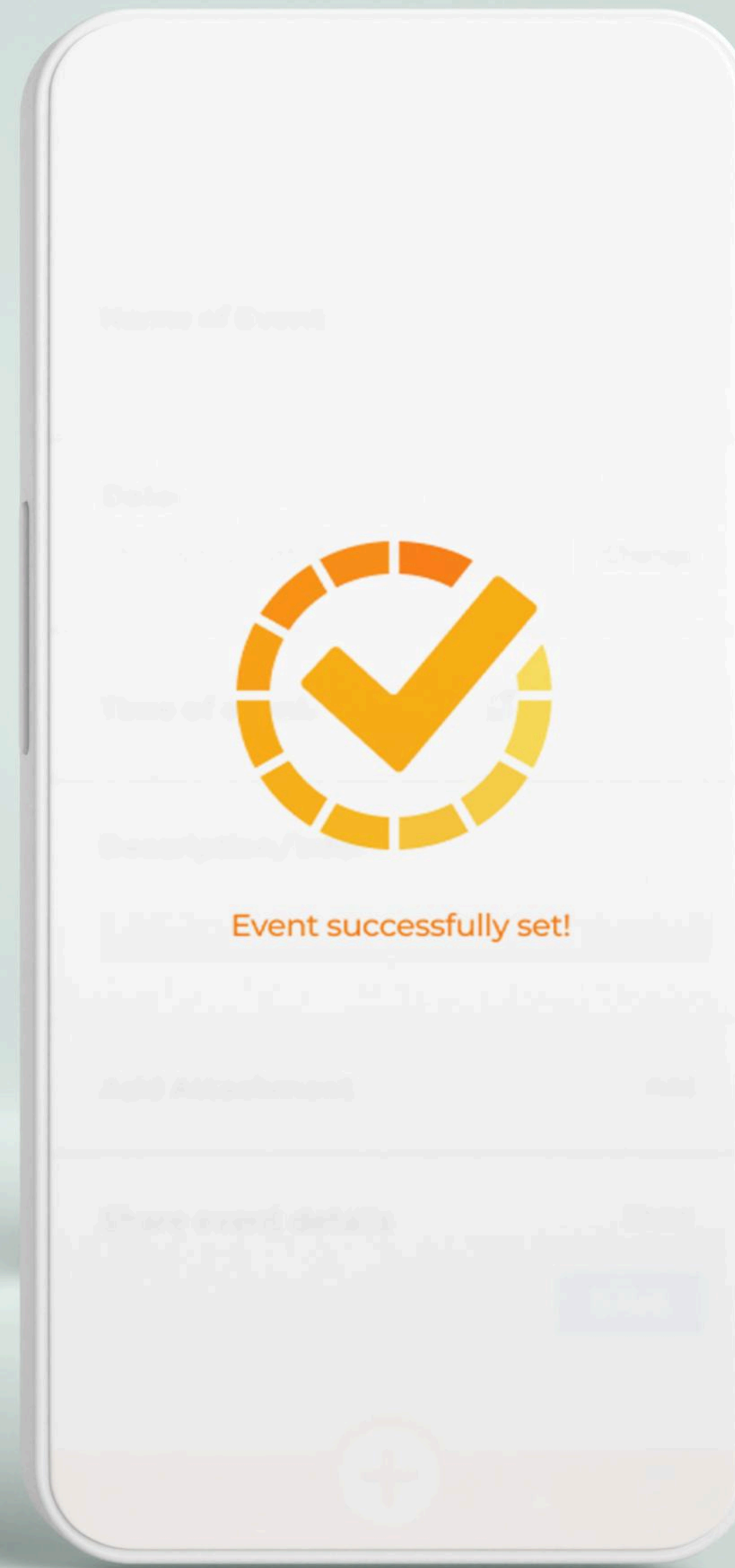
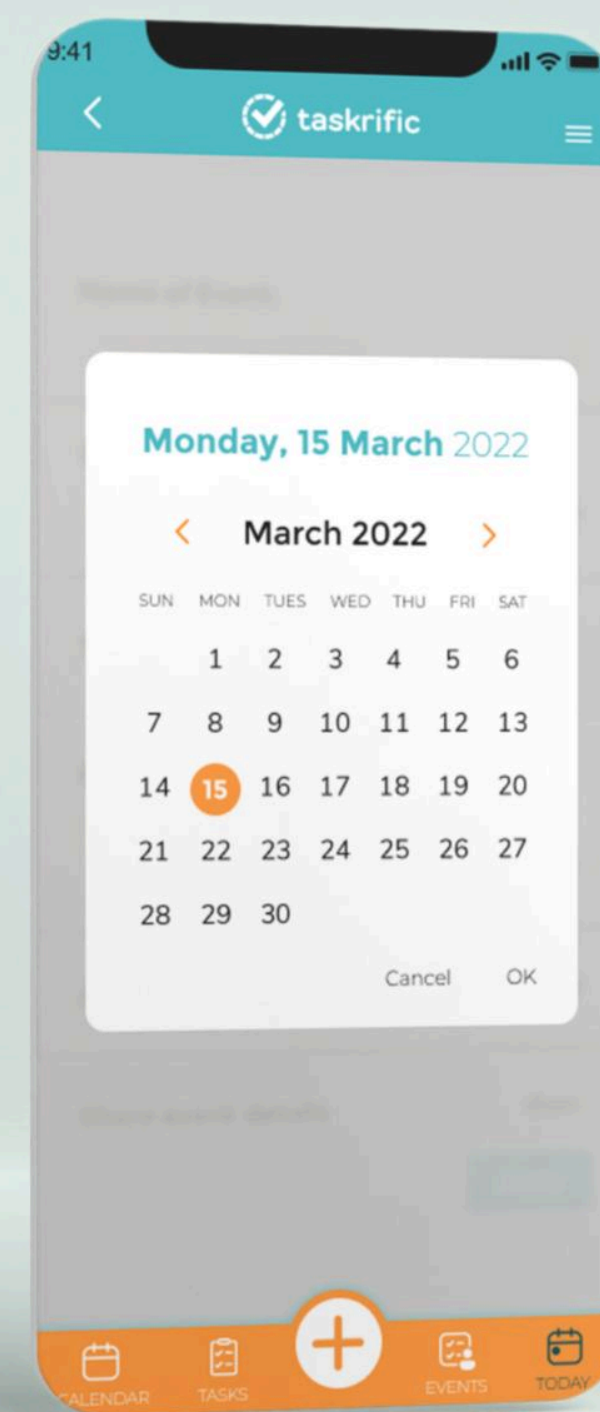
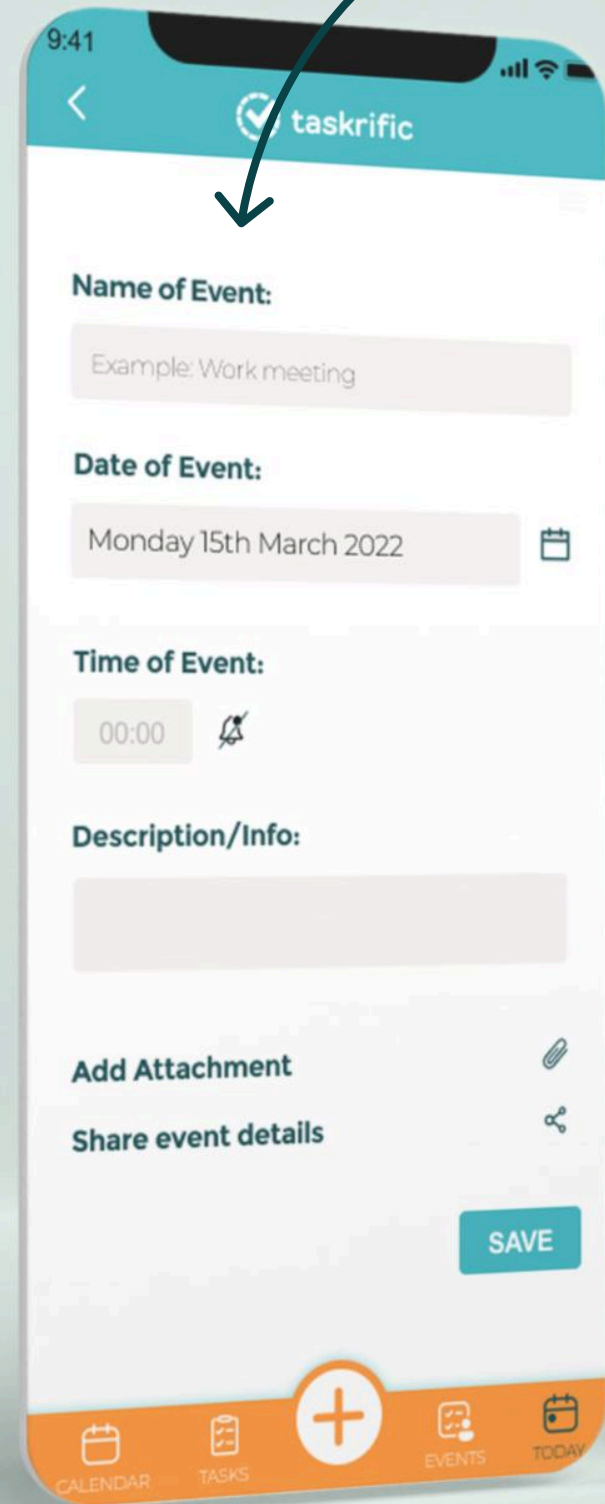
Easy Sharing option
